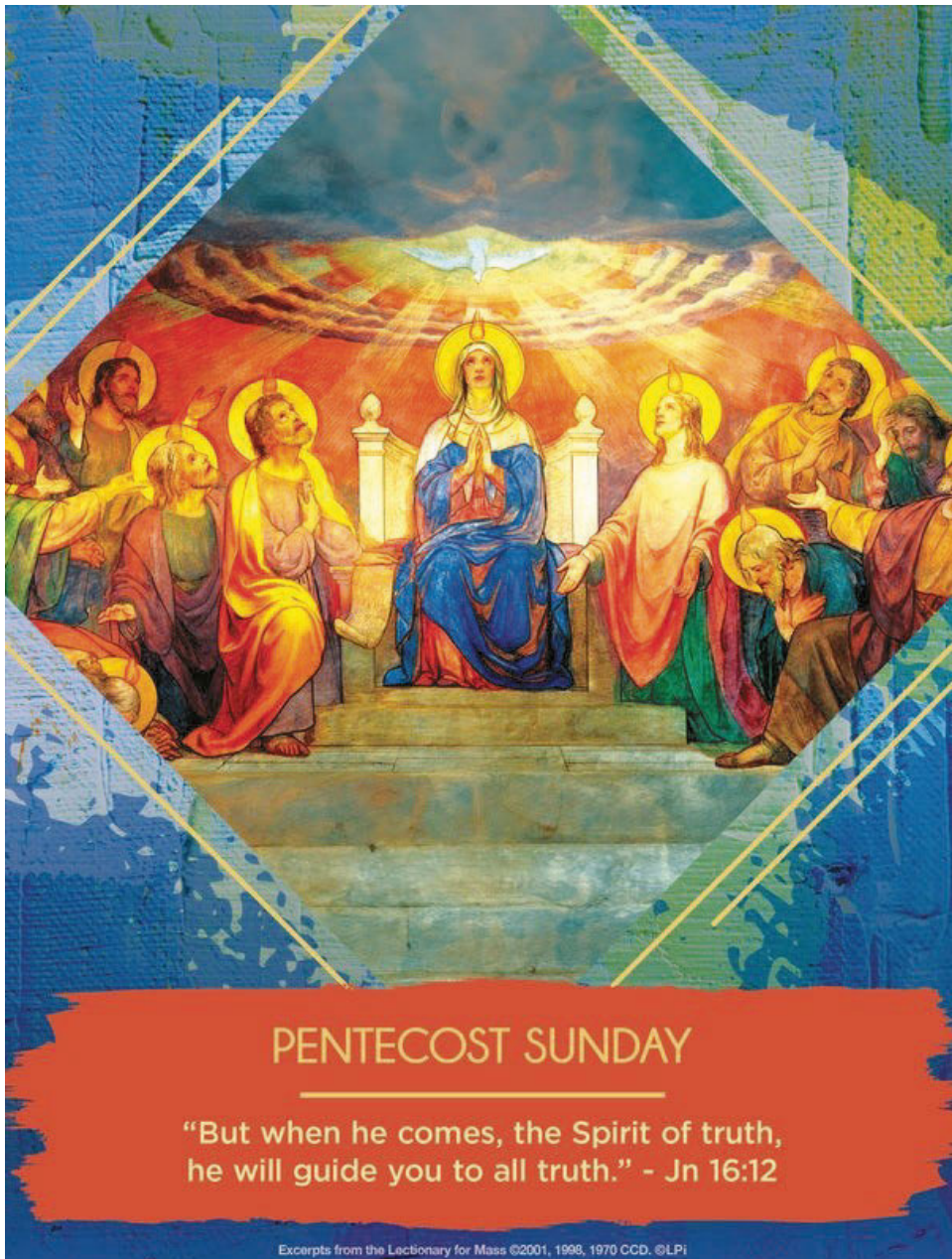

Dear Friends,

I love this time of the year for so many reasons!! I truly love Spring and the promise of beautiful weather and all the new growth – the blossoming trees and tulips and daffodils remind me of God's constant presence in our lives. And I also love the changes it brings to our 2nd graders!!

This spring I have been able to spend time with these young ones – along with Frs. Watts and Ryan – teaching them about God's love and forgiveness. Back in January we prepared the children for their First Reconciliation. The message is that God does not want to be separated from us....He knows that we are not perfect, nor does He expect it....so He has given us the gift of Reconciliation so that we can tell God we are sorry for having hurt Him and receive His forgiveness. And we can do this as often as we need to do so....in order to always keep close to Him. If you were one of the lucky parishioners who received a paper lamb when the 2nd graders gave them to participants at Mass back in November, I hope you were able to keep your student in your prayers as he or she prepared for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.

On May 4th, the majority of our 2nd graders received their First Holy Communion at one of 3 Masses that day. And for the next few weeks, you may see one or two (or more) receiving for the first time at one of our regular Sunday Masses. We held special "retreat" days for all the children, both Saints JFX school children and Family of Faith children. It is important for them to know that they are all part of our parish family. They had the opportunity to work together on projects in a relaxed setting. I am very grateful, too, for the cooperation of the parents, who also presented and reviewed prayers and lessons to prepare their children for this Sacrament. Parents are the first teachers of their children, and if the parents are not vested, their children will not be either.

Additionally, I want to report that our first year of the new Family of Faith program has gone very smoothly. I greatly appreciate the cooperation of our families in adapting to this program, which is so different from how we handled religious education in the past. Parents attended sessions once a month on Tuesdays and attended the 4:45 pm Mass with their families once a month. These Masses were followed by dinner for all in the SJ School cafeteria and also included a special project that everyone could work on together. I am grateful to Men's Club, the Women's Club, and Zier's Prime Meats, the for providing the meals. We conclude our year this Sunday by celebrating at the 4:45 pm Mass then meeting for dinner in the school gym. If you are interested in learning more about the Family of Faith program, please consider attending the Mass then join us in the gym for dinner. All are Welcome.

We at Saints Joseph and Francis Xavier are truly blessed, and I am so grateful.

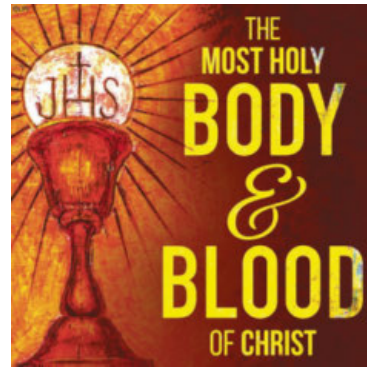

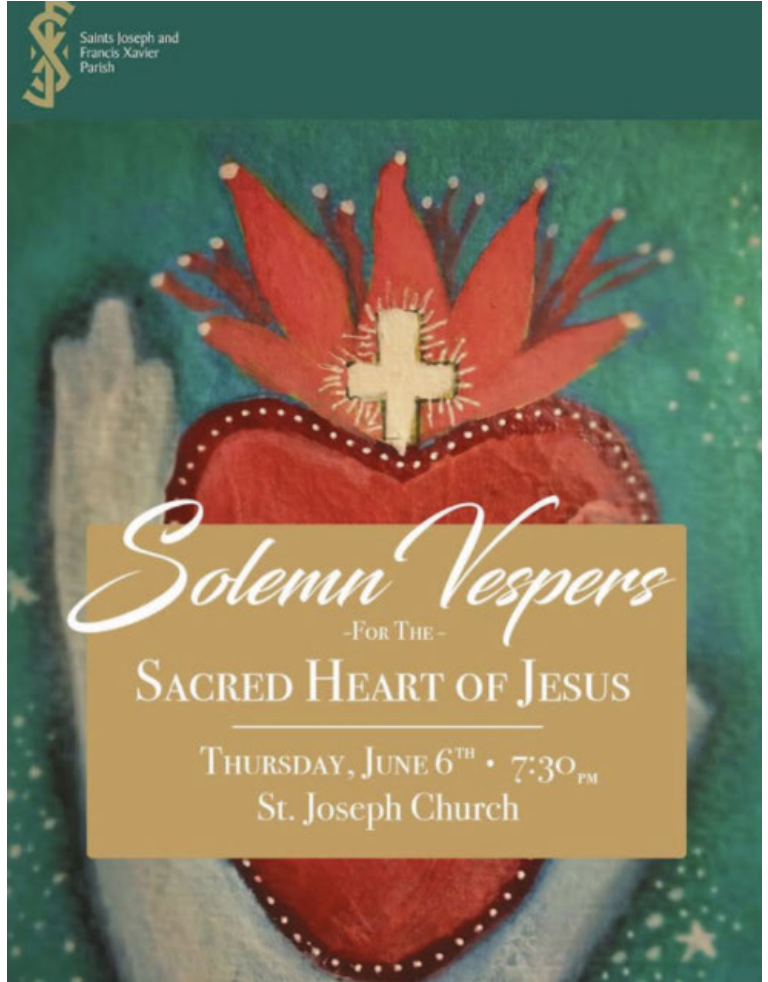

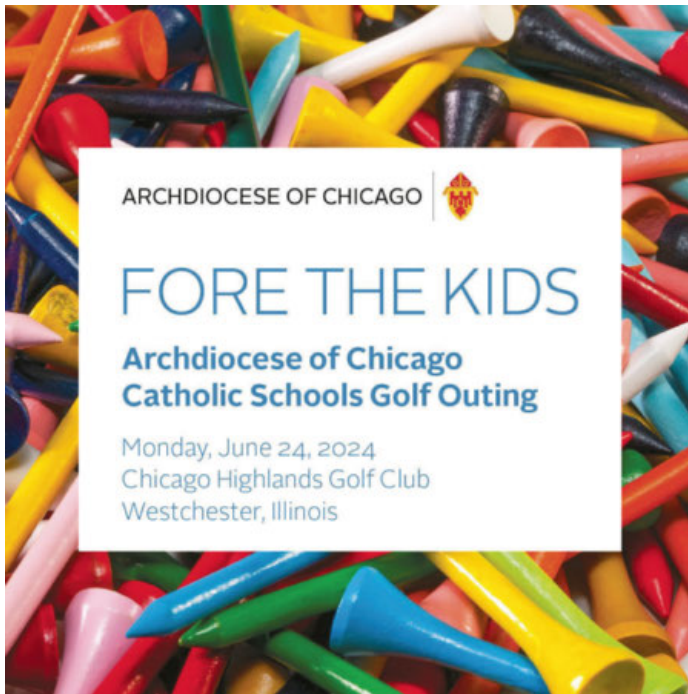
