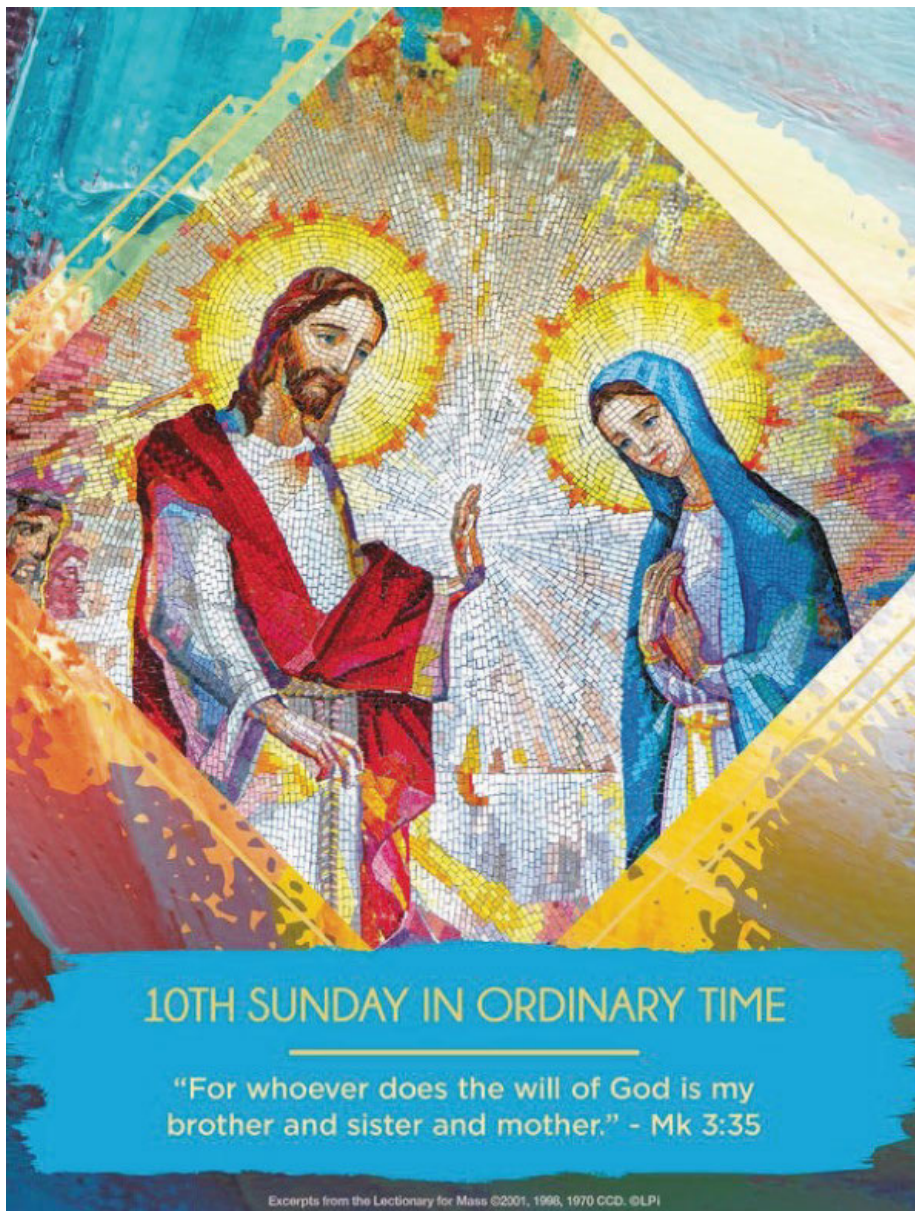

Dear Friends,

Today's first reading demonstrates that the politics of blaming has gone on since the beginning of creation – well not really since the beginning of creation, but since the fall of humankind. After their sins of pride and disobedience, instead of taking responsibility for their actions and trying to determine the motivation for the act, they begin the blame game. Adam blames Eve (and maybe even God since God put Eve on Earth). And Eve blames the serpent. No human takes responsibility for the act and no one is able to determine the motivation for the disobedient, prideful behavior. The first humans spend too much time pointing fingers at others, creating tension and division; thus they have no time for self-reflection and improved behavior. We humans have continued that pattern for eons since. We hear the disappointment in the voice of the Creator.

The tensions and divisions, resulting from the Fall, appear again in the relationship between Jesus and the people of his day. They think he is crazy. They accuse him of being possessed by the devil. They do not want to hear what he has to say because his words demand self-reflection, conversion and improved behavior. So they begin pointing fingers and calling names. Their hard hearts prevent him from accomplishing God-works in them. As much as God wants closeness, human refusal to look at self and take responsibility prevents it. As much as God wants harmony and peace, human blaming and finger pointing derails it.

The blaming continues today. We witness it in the political arena and in personal relationships. Many school administrators (not so much ours, thank God!) see this lack of accepting personal responsibility for actions even in parents' defense of their children – in the "not my child" syndrome. When I was a child, if the teacher or principal called a student out for behavior or missing work, parents would support the educators wholeheartedly. The responsibility would be taken, and consequences assigned. More and more these days, when situations come up, parents balk, defend the child, point fingers at other kids, and the teachers and administrators are blamed.

From creation to Jesus, to present day relationships, the imperfection of the human condition and the refusal to take personal responsibility threaten harmony and spiritual closeness to God who so desires it. God's grace, the free will that He has given us, and the intellect that we all possess point us in the direction of goodness. The Holy Spirit promised to the disciples and given to us in the Sacraments can help us to overcome these human frailties. Focusing on obedience to God's will and responsibility for our own behavior (individual and corporate) will bring joy.

Mark's Gospel for today uses Mary in juxtaposition to Eve, to exemplify obedience and responsibility. Some people wonder about Jesus' apparent rejection of his mother and brothers. In fact, he uses Mary to remind us all of how to be close to him. Read the words of the Gospel again,

"Who are my mother and my brothers?" And looking around at those seated in the circle he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."



I often think of this comment of Jesus when I pray the Lord's prayer. Just think of how many times we pray that prayer each day. When we pray for the coming of the Kingdom, we also pray that God's will be done. I wonder if we mean it. We say, "Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done." But do we mean, "thy Kingdom come, my will be done?" Doing the will of God requires humility of heart and openness to the movement of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit will direct us in marvelous ways when we commit, when it's easy and when it's difficult, to doing God's will. Amazing things happen. I've experienced it in my own personal life. God desires our closeness, that we make best use of the gifts he's given us, and our willingness to move beyond what is comfortable. And God gives us the Holy Spirit to guide and protect us throughout life's journey.

Personal responsibility for one's actions and a true desire to do the will of God will bring closeness to Jesus. Closeness to Jesus will bring joy. True Christian joy will attract others. Attracting others will build the kingdom of God to life here on earth and will prepare us for eternal happiness with God in the life to come. Sounds easy, doesn't it?

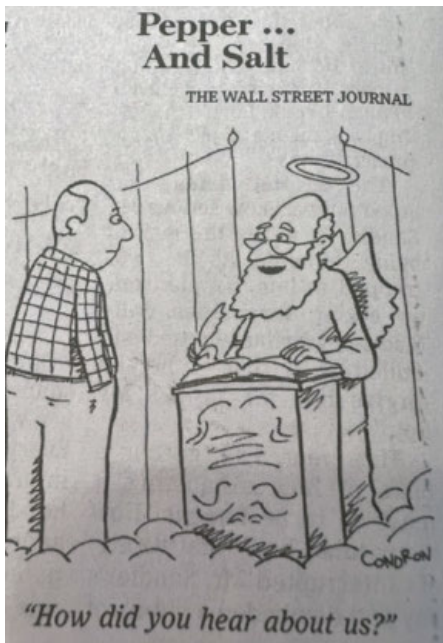

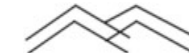
